A spring bestival: Easter

#### Easter is a celebration of spring and life.

S pring has arrived, and the light of day is moving forward daily. Easter is a festival of growth, purification, fertility and vitality.

Do you remember your own youth? In Germany on Easter Sunday, the young girls met before dawn and hiked to a spring, a river or a creek near the forest, on the mountain or in the floodplains. This happened in silence - no word could be spoken to not destroy the magic. Arrived at the water, the young women washed and drank from the refreshing water. This was reputed to give them health, youthfulness and beauty. Our mothers did that as well and still enjoy the memory. The Neustadter Ottilienquelle (Ottilien spring) on the Muppberg near Roedental was the destination that they visited with their friends.

#### The universal remedy: "Easter water"

The water from the spring was poured into jugs and taken home. As a "cure-all" it was used as a remedy for headaches, fever or eye problems. Some farmers also drove their cattle through the river before dawn to protect them from disease all year round.

The Easter egg is a fertility symbol and stands for evolution and the emergence of new life. By giving each other Easter eggs, you spread blessing and strength. Easter bonfires date back to pagan times. On Easter Saturday they are still lit on fields, mountains and hills. These fires have a purifying and defensive purpose.

## The highest festival of the church year

For Christians, Easter is the oldest and highest festival in the church year. In the night to Easter, between Holy Saturday and Easter Sunday, the resurrection of Jesus Christ is celebrated. The Catholic Church associates Christ, "the Lamb of God," with the sacrificial Lamb: "For we too have a Passover lamb, that is Christ who is sacrificed" (1 Cor. 4:7). In many families, therefore, a lamb was prepared at Easter. Easter Saturday marks the end of Lent, meat is again allowed, which accounts for the symbolism between Easter and the lamb.

#### First Communion and Confirmation

I n early Christian times, those baptized at Easter wore their white christening gowns for a whole week as a sign of their bond with Jesus. Only then did the candidates remove these special clothes. That's where the so-called White Sunday comes from, when Catholic children receive their first holy communion. This day is traditionally the Sunday after Easter. Around this time, many young Protestants are also confirmed.

But whether confirmation or communion – on their day of honor the children and young people are in the (ecclesiastical) center. After the festive church service, where the young girls and boys are festively dressed, neighbors, relatives, friends and acquaintances congratulate, flowers and gifts are presented and of course souvenir photos are taken. A traditional meal – with us in Franconia, often with roasts and potato dumplings – is an integral part of the day. A visit by the pastor to the family at home with a cup of coffee and a piece of homemade cake is often also part of the festival. An afternoon stroll through the village, the town or the church garden rounds out a very special festive day.
